This bountiful elixir constantly evolves in the glass, so take your time and fully experience its joyous depths.</i>

<i>Classy, opulent and powerful, yet not at all OTT. Carefully restrained oak spice underpins rather than overwhelms the flavours of fresh stone fruits, honey and roasted hazelnuts. A trophy wine, what a treat!</i>

As cuddly as cashmere and equally as seductive. Vanilla-spiced dark plum, cedar and tobacco, Christmas cake and milk chocolate. Right-bank Merlot-rich Clarets are already drinking well from this sinewy vintage.

## EURO STARS

These are our local heroes, benchmark classics old and new that we return to time and again. These producers are all at the top of their game; from the impressive Crasto Superior in the picturesque Douro to a blow-out Burgundy to die for. And who doesn't love a top flight Rioja Reserva from a cracking vintage such as this?

Dripping with bountiful inky fruit and subtle cinnamon spice, we urge you to dip into this divine Douro. These vertiginous vineyards produce superlative reds, as stunning as the spectacular scenery.

**Rioja Reserva, Marqués de Riscal** 2010 Spain 14% **32.50**

Red Rioja is a chameleon and wears many hats, but classic Reserva is the benchmark star of the show. Truffled berries, mocha, coconut and sweet spices, supremely harmonious and mature. Loves lamb.

**Vosne-Romanée, Domaine Gros Frère et Soeur** 2012 France 13% **65.00**

Exactly how great Burgundy should be; headily-scented hedgerow fruits, a warm heart of smoke-y oak spice, hints of sweet earth and game. Teeny tiny production, spoil yourself before it all goes!

Decidedly red fruit-forward with lashings of fragrant freshly-ground pepper. Serious, in a good way.

**Beaujolais Vieilles Vignes, Domaine du Vissoux** 2014 France 12.5% **28.00**

Quintessential warm-weather quaffing with serious credentials (old vines, single domaine, sustainable). We love the classic crunch of juicy cranberry and redcurrant and a waft of leafy florals. Beyond cool.

**Chinon 'Les Morinières', Joseph Mellot** 2013/14 France 12.5% **26.50**

A blast of violets and aromatic herbs and the twang of freshly picked berries all bounce energetically out of the glass. Typical Loire Valley vim and verve, Cabernet Franc rocks!
